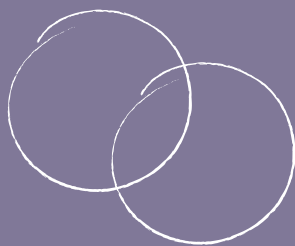


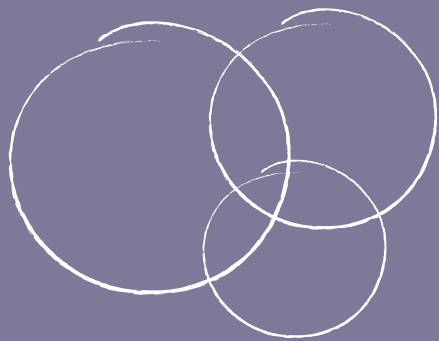
# Captivated Hearts

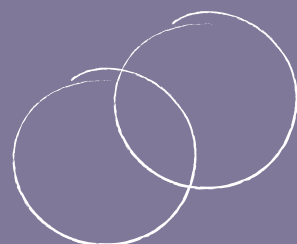



# Holy moments

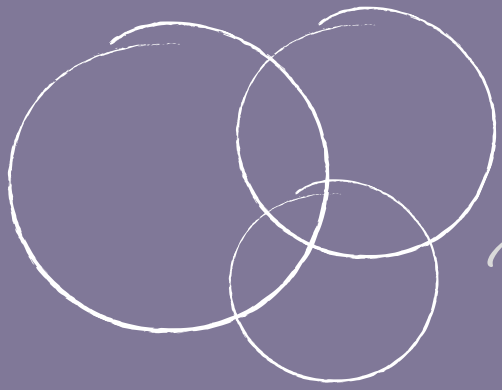
Come without warning. When we least expect it,

completely surrendered to Him.

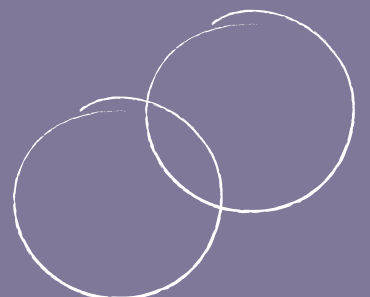






## Psalm 63:1-8

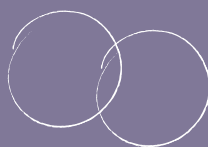
God, you are my God; I eagerly seek you.

your right hand holds on to me. (CSB)







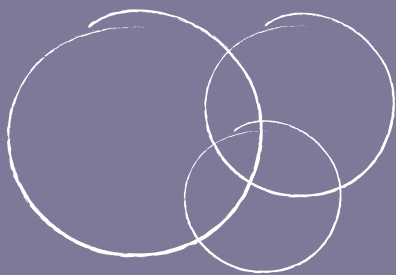
*When* holy moments come and God moves in your heart one thing is for sure - Your life will never be the same! You drop to your knees and utter words you never thought you'd pray.

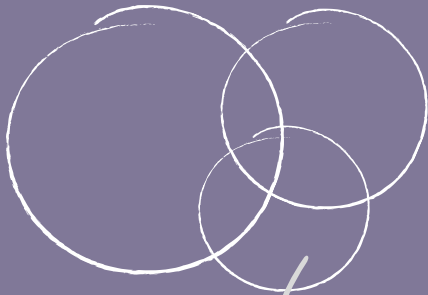
